- 1 January – Restoration Day of the Independent Czech State
- 8 May – Liberation Day
- 5 July – Saints Cyril and Methodius Day
- 6 July – Jan Hus Day
- 28 September – St. Wenceslas Day (Czech Statehood Day)
- 28 October – Independent Czechoslovak State Day
- 17 November – Struggle for Freedom and Democracy Day

Other holidays

- 1 January – New Year's Day
- Good Friday – movable feast, friday before Easter Monday
- Easter Monday – movable feast depending on the first spring full moon
- 1 May – Labour Day
- 24 December – Christmas Eve
- 25 December – Christmas Day
- 26 December – Boxing Day
